
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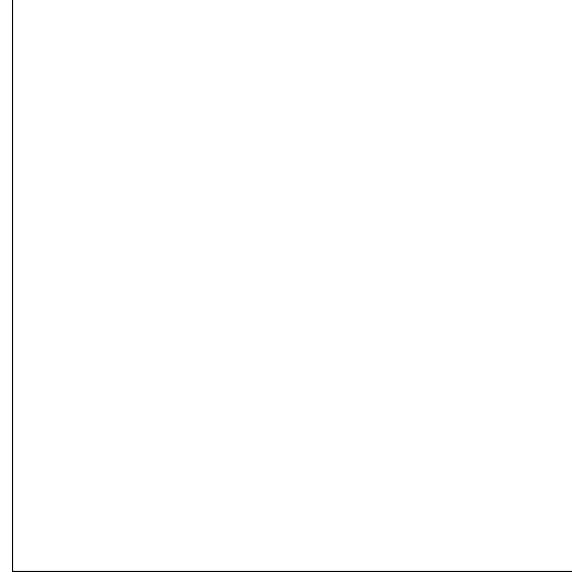
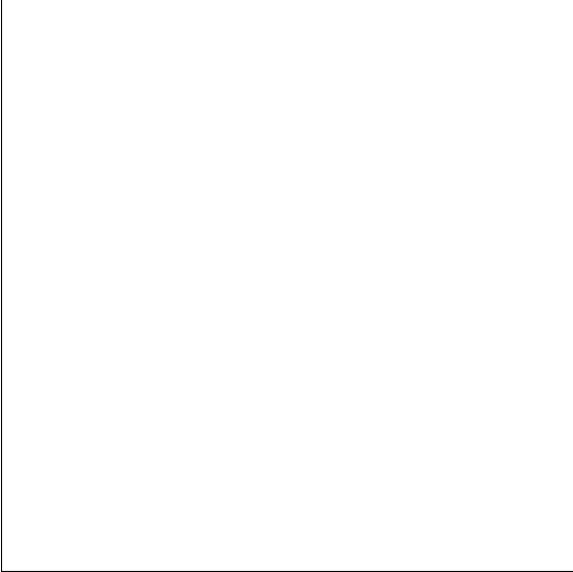
One day, Rabbit was walking by the riverside.

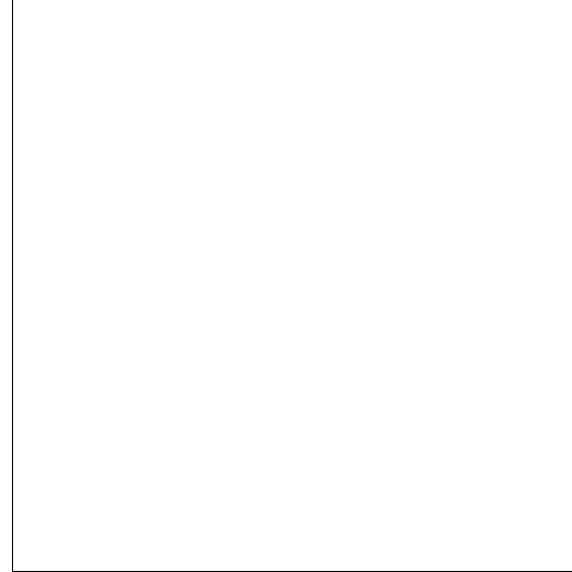
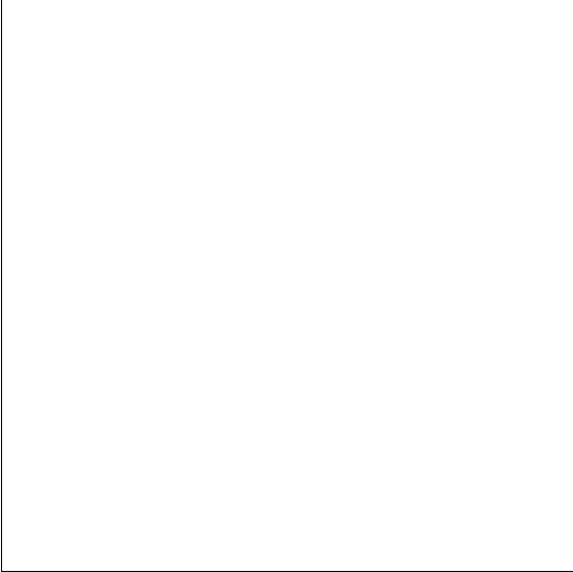


Hippo started to cry and ran for the water. All
