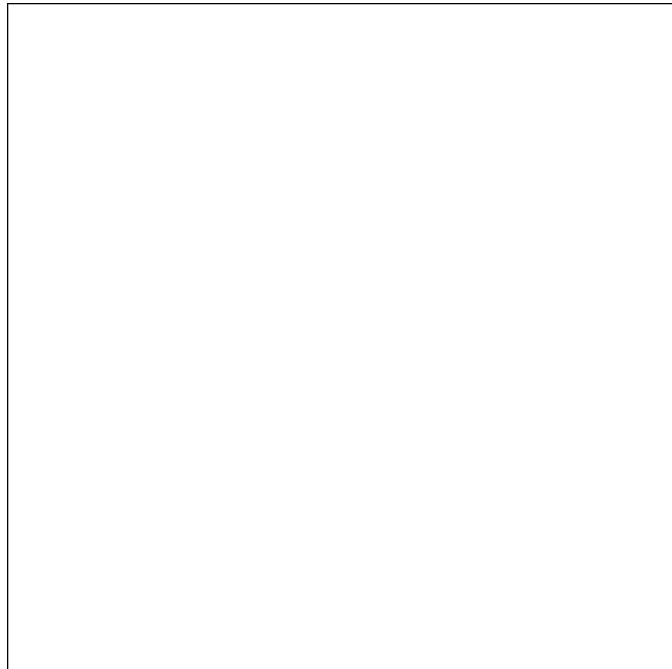





One elephant is going to drink

Two giraffes are going to drink






Three buffaloes and four birds  
are also going to drink water.


One elephant is drinking water
