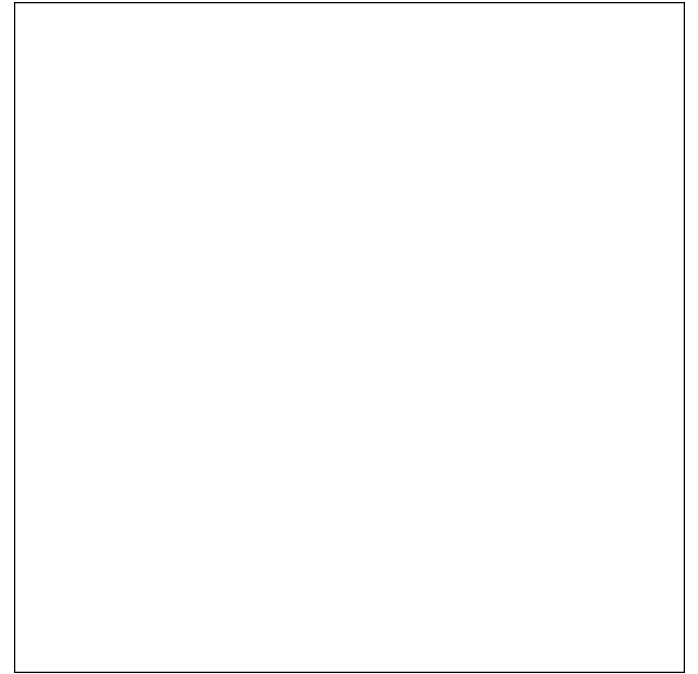

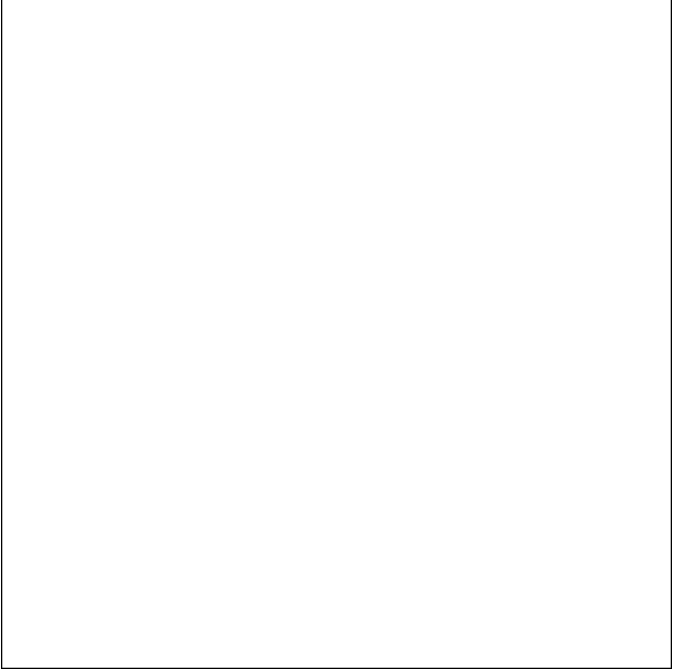

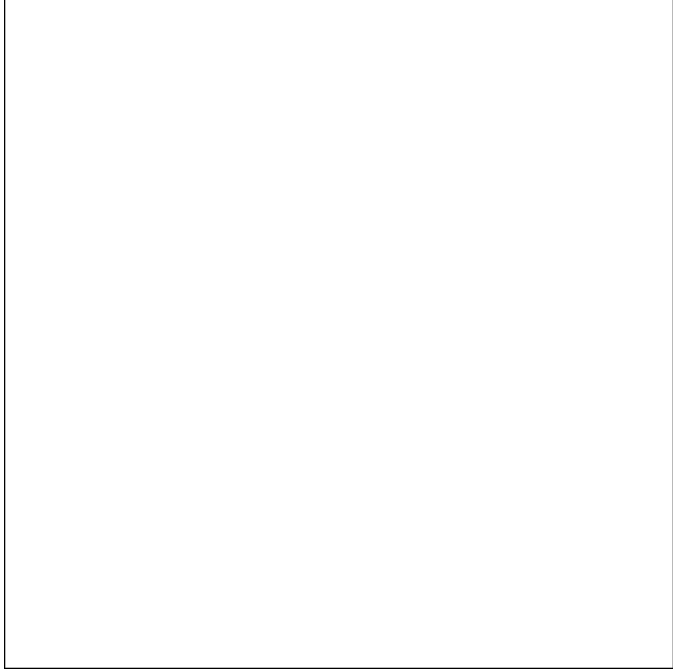


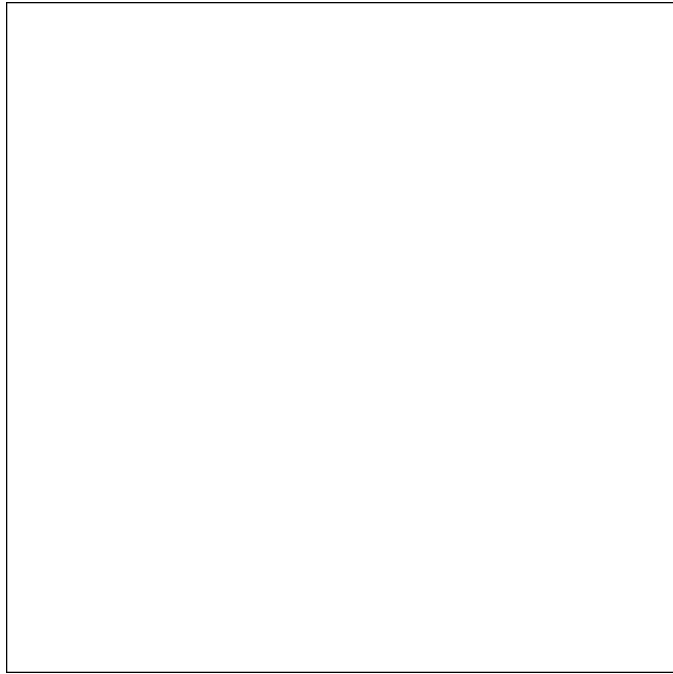
Un elefante está bebiendo

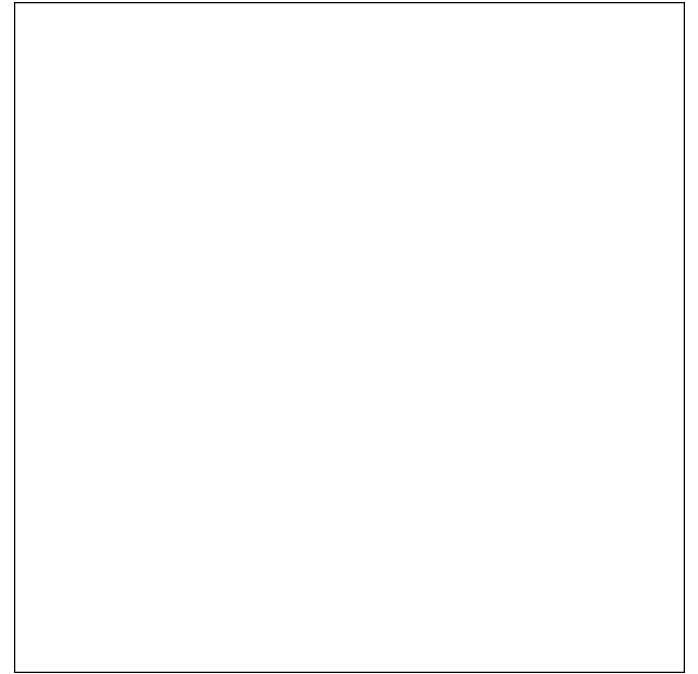


Un león rugie. También quiere
