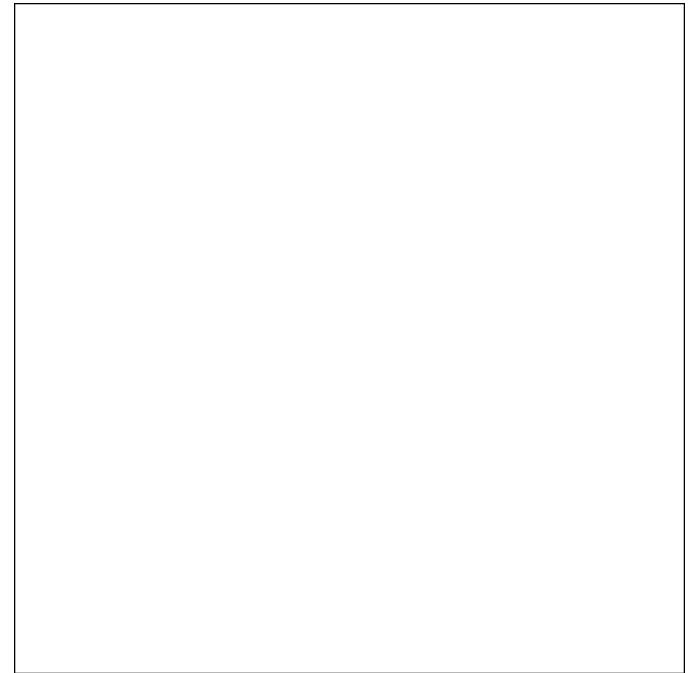
Meu irmãozinho dorme até muito tarde. Eu acordo cedo porque sou demais!

Eu sou daquelas que deixa o sol entrar.



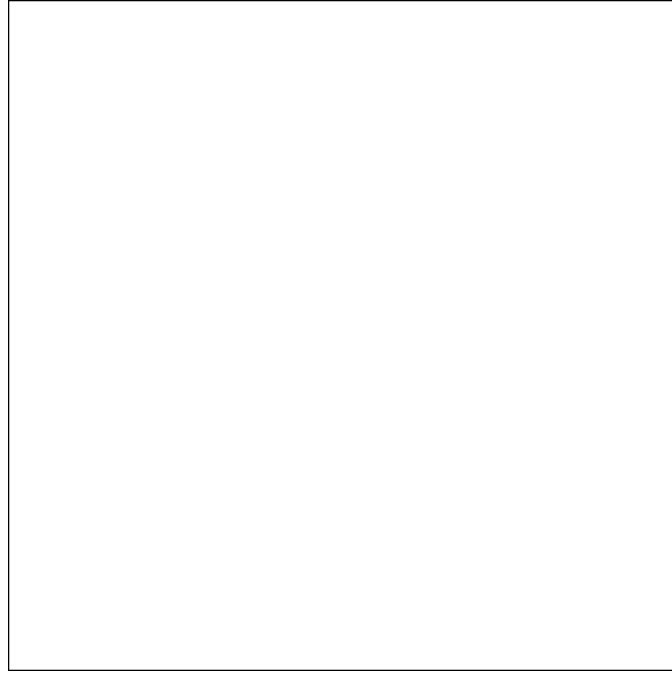
